Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyaan is a noble initiative of the Indian government in the direction of improvement in general hygiene and sanitation. The Abhiyaan has been launched to provide separate toilets for boys and girls in all the government schools throughout the country.

The construction of new toilets as well as repairs of dysfunctional toilets has been undertaken

by the central public sector undertakings under the Ministries of Power, Coal and New & Renewable Energy and will spend their CSR funds for construction/repair of the said toilets in schools that are having inadequate toilets.

The role of Chartered Accountants is to physically verify the completed school toilet blocks/units constructed/repared by the concerned CPSUs under the Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyaan on pro bono basis and report the said verification in the format provided by ICAI.
